- 4. Trustee Debbie Engel speaks to the trustees priority for the years being to lobby for more space. Soon we will have all schools, even high schools at or over 100% capacity. The district has the land to build schools but has not gotten any approvals or funding from the government to build on that land. This year a 3% growth was expected, the actual growth was double that at 6%. Edmonton Public Schools are in the same boat. What the public may see is an increase in private or charter schools which is not desirable for families who are not in a position to access them. There is also a significant shortage of teachers and support staff, especially for when substitutes are need when regular teachers are off.
- 5. **Presenters from the North East Hub and C5. Daniel and Tolu.** Spoke about the youth outreach supports available at the Clareview Recreation Centre. Program is located on the main level by the hockey arenas and all programs are at no cost.
